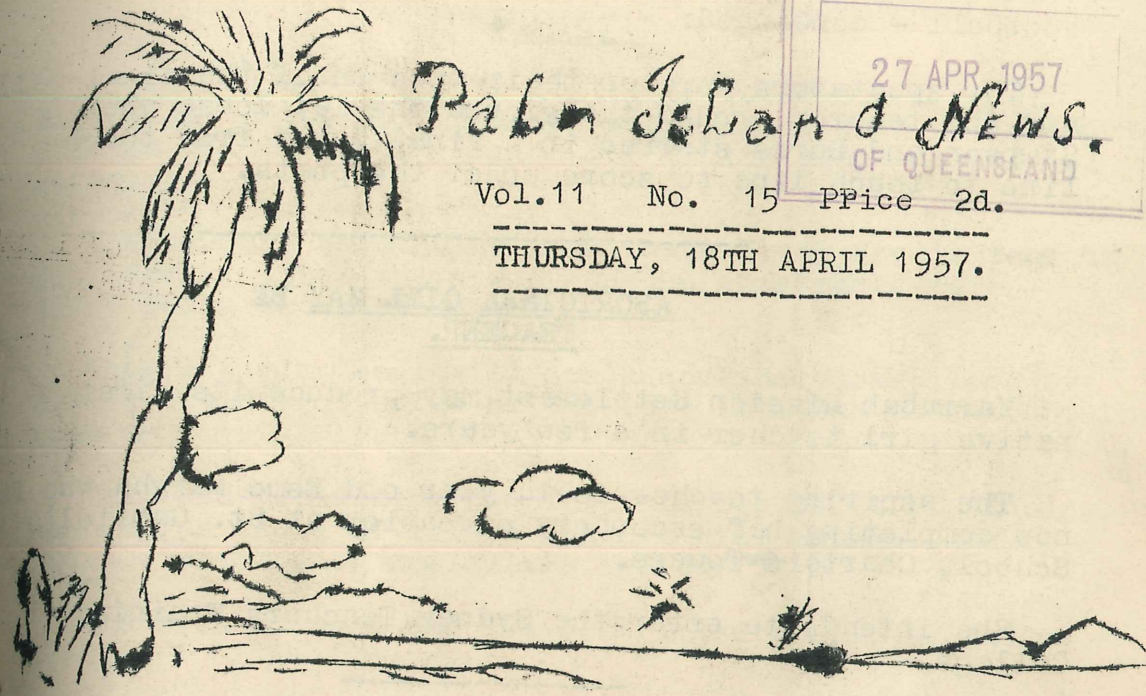

Have You Tried This?

Baking a cake which you want to decorate by sprinkling coconut, butts or sultanas on top? Then soak those ingredients in milk for some time before putting them on top of the cake and they will then not dry out so rapidly while the cake is baking and be much more palatable.

Secret of crisp batter for coating fish or other fried foods is to omit egg when making. Add half a small teaspoon of soda bicarb. to plain flour and mix with cold water to desired consistency. Egg batter always goes soft.
