

FOOTBALL NEWS

After several attempts to hold a General meeting of all interested in a football season for 1954, sufficient members came along last week Thursday afternoon.

It was decided to field three senior and three junior teams this year and that the season would officially open the first week end following Easter.

As there seemed to be some slight dissatisfaction at the methods used last season to arrange the teams, it was decided that this year we change the procedure.

All persons wishing to play football this season are asked to register with their Secretary as soon as possible. The Grading Committee will then grade the players into three well balanced senior teams and three junior teams.

The Committee will then confer with each team in its selection of a Captain.

Attention was drawn to the shortage of football jerseys and it was agreed to ask the Executive Committee to purchase four new sets for this season.

Quite a lengthy debate on jerseys followed and finally Jack Ebbagoolavolunteered to act as equipment manager to see that all jerseys are handed in after each match, laundered and carefully stored until required for the next match.

All jerseys will be numbered so it will be easier to trace the players who do not hand back their jerseys after a match.

Each team will have a different colour so this should make it easier to find out if a junior or senior player is the culprit.

Players and committee men should find these conditions more suitable for keeping a better check on their equipment.

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
