Bottling Hints:-

For jam bottling never use jars that have contained
any oil or grease, for no matter how well they have

When making a quantity of jam cut some rounds of
tissue paper the size of the mouth of the jar, soak each

the top of the jar of jam.

Seed Planting:-

When planting very fine seeds, dig a small
