The first aboriginal to be granted a cattle grazing licence in North Australia is 47-year-old artist, Albert Namatjira, whose pictures have brought him fame and fortune.

The licence is for from 400 to 500 square miles of country about 200 miles slightly north of west of Alice Springs.

Like all cattle men in the Territory, Albert will be free of income tax on money earned through his property, but he will be taxed on his income from his paintings.

These have already earned him anything up to £1500. Some of his paintings have several times brought 55 guineas.
